

## ARRIVAL OF HER HONOUR THE VICE PRESIDENT - BANGKOK, THAILAND

The Vice President of the Republic of Zambia, Her Honour Mrs Inonge Wina MP, has said concerted efforts are needed by all stakeholders if hunger is to be reduced. Mrs. Wina said this when she arrived at the Suvarnabhumi International Airport in Bangkok, Kingdom of Thailand on 26th November, 2018.

The Republican Vice President expressed concern at the malnutrition levels and stunted growth amongst children that Zambia is grappling with.
